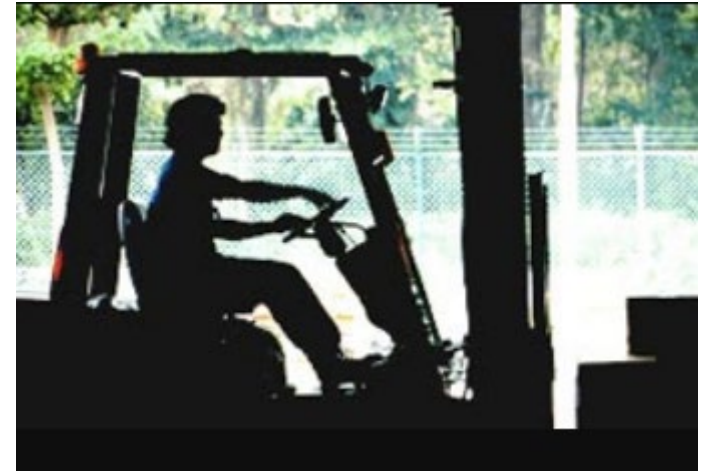


# Best Practice – Material Offloading

# Best Practice – Material Offloading

## Best Practice Summary

- Cones/Flagging/Barricades are used to create a “No Go Zone” when loading / unloading trucks
- Stanchions are required:
  - On the opposite side of the trailer when offloading with a forklift
  - On both sides of the trailer when offloading with a crane
